

TECHNICAL REPORT ABOUT THE MAINTENANCE OF THE SUPPLEMENTARY FEEDING STATIONS IN ALBANIA Autumn 2019

Since may this year, both Supplementary Feeding Stations (SFS) are operating in Albania; the one of Glina constructed in 2017 and the one of Nivica, constructed in in July 2018.

PPNEA has contracted two locals for the feeding and maintenance of the SFS.

Along July-September 2019 the supplementary feeding station of Glina has been supplied 4 times a week with an average of 5 kg meat remains/ supply! On the other hand the supplementary feeding of Nivica has been feed only twice with an amount of 30 kg of meat remains in total.

The station of Glina is monitored by camera trap, which confirms that it is regularly visited so far by three different individuals. The pair of Peshkpi-Radat and the single individual of Vllaho-Goranxi. In addition, this station is visited by Ravens and Hooded Crows. The station has also been visited by the juveniles.

The station of Nivica is not monitored by camera trap, therefore we do not know if this station is visited or not.

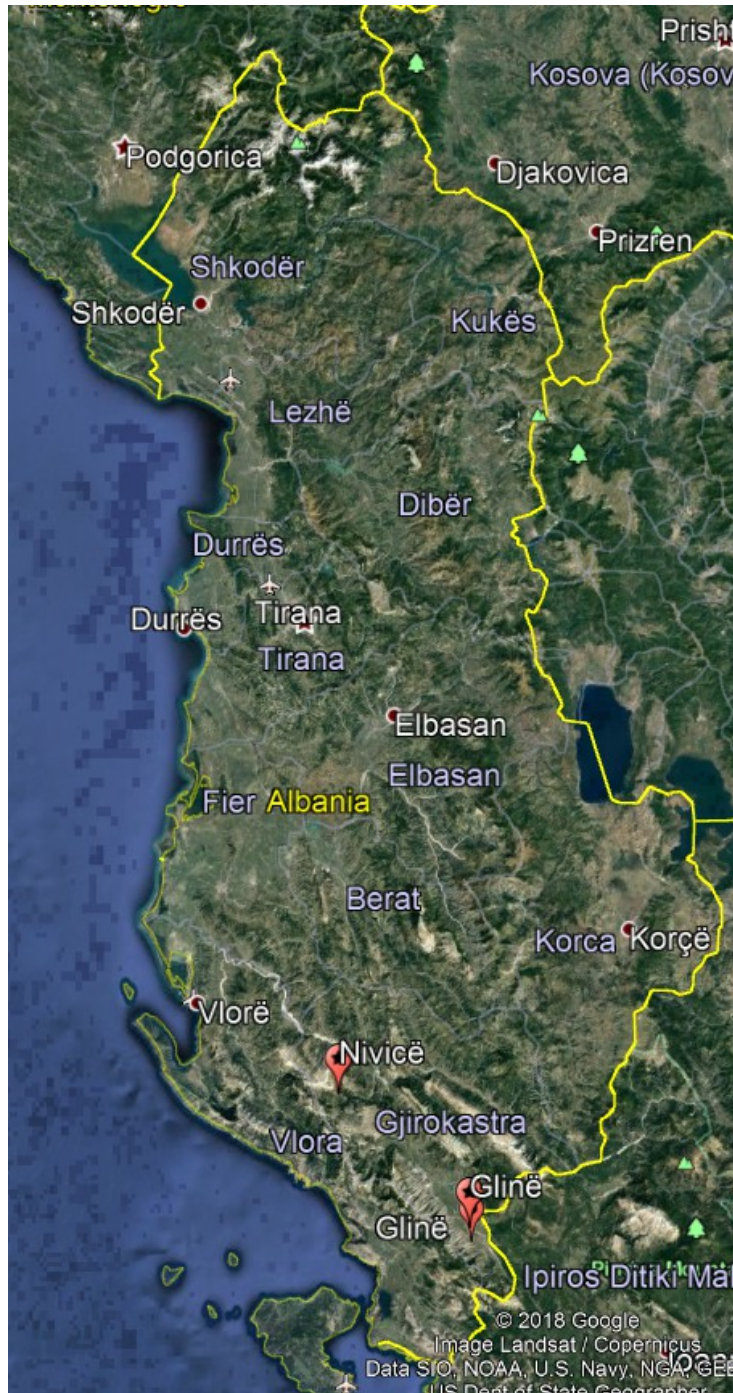
